NOTICE TO ALL CLEARED CANDIDATES

The following is the list of approved aspirants for various positions. Areas marked in yellow are on tentative approval until the missing documents are availed to the SATUK 2025/2026 Electoral Board in Block N Room 023F.

Departments without delegates elections:

- 1. Department of Architecture, Design and Planning (DADP)
- 2. Department of Chemistry and Materials Science (DCMS)

Departments with one gender aspirant election:

In the Department of Liberal Development and International Studies (DLDIS) **five male** aspirants go for delegates elections, while the female aspirant goes unopposed. In the Department of Hospitality and Human Ecology (DHHE) **five female** aspirants go for election, while the male candidate is unopposed.

The Department of Information Science, Language and Communication Studies (DILCS) is expected to provide a list of female aspirants for delegate elections.

Please NOTE that the SATUK ELECTORAL BOARD will be meeting all the cleared candidates tomorrow Wednesday, 23rd April, 2025 at 2:00pm in the Lecture Theatre. In the meantime, the campaign period officially starts today Tuesday, 22rd April, 2025 and will end at mid night on Sunday, 27th April, 2025.

Take note of the following Rules and Regulations during this period:

SATUK 2025/2026 ELECTIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Campaign will officially begin on Tuesday, 22nd April, 2025 and close on Sunday, 27th April, 2025 at mid-night;
- Candidates must abide by all University rules and Regulations and laws of Kenya
- 3. A duly nominated candidate shall ensure that posters and all campaign materials are **NOT** posted on notice Boards.
- 4. No candidate or their agent may use glue for displaying posters and other campaign materials on any surface such as walls, floors, corridors, windows, doors etc.
- 5. The following are allowed for campaign;
 - Use of banners;
 - Fliers, brochures, placards, T-shirts;
 - Social Media;
 - Kamukunjis/Barazas
 - Lecture halls/Hostel visits;
 - Person to person campaigns;
- 6. No campaign outside the **University Precincts** or around **Administration** block.
- 7. No bribery of voters, threats and hooliganism shall be tolerated.
- 8. There shall be no campaigning on Election Day Monday 28th and Tuesday, 29th April, 2025.

- **9**. Candidates must not use abusive language at opponents and university staff during the campaigns.
- 10 Use of violence against individuals or any activities that may lead to destruction of property of The Technical University of Kenya by a candidate or his/her agents and supporters is strictly prohibited. This shall lead to automatic disqualification.
