This workshop is designed to address the critical need of elevating research capacities and funding opportunities, and enhancing the sustainability of research ecosystem across countries in the global South, specifically in the eastern Africa region. The workshop will be targeting mid-career (Ph.D students and those who earned their doctorates less than 5 years ago) academic staff and researchers. The workshop participants are academic staff and researchers from TUK, University of Nairobi, Jomo Kenyatta University of Science and Technology, Daystar University, South Eastern Kenya University, University of Eastern Africa, Baraton, Maseno University and KIRDI.
