Applications are now open for the DARA Basic Training 2026 - 27. All the information can be found here: <https://www.dara-project.org/basic-program>

The programme is for any recent graduates in physics or a related subject from: Botswana, Ghana, **Kenya**, Madagascar, Mozambique, Namibia, Zambia, or South Africa. No prior experience of astrophysics is required.

The training comprises of four intensive training units, spread throughout the year (June 2026 - February 2027). Covering: astrophysics; technical training in using a radio telescope; radio astronomy observation; data reduction and analysis; and computer programming. Training is delivered by experts from the project's UK and South Africa partners, as well as local partners in each country.
