NOTICE TO ALL STUDENTS

REVISED DEADLINE FOR SIGNING OF THE NOMINAL ROLL (A Prerequisite for Examination Eligibility)

The Second Semester of the 2025/2026 Academic Year began on 23rd February, 2026 and is expected to end on 30th May, 2026 with End-of-Semester Examinations from 18th May, 2026 to 30th May, 2026.

1. Extended deadline for Signing of the Nominal Roll

Because University policy mandates that all students register each semester by signing the official Nominal Roll on the student portal within the first three (3) weeks, the deadline was set at Friday, 13th March, 2026. However senate has approved extension to Friday 17th April 2026

Deadline: Friday, 13th March, 2026

Only students with a zero fee balance from the preceding semester may sign the Nominal Roll.

2. Consequences of Failure to Sign

Failure to sign the Nominal Roll by the stated deadline will result in:

- i. Exclusion from TuSoft-generated class lists used for attendance verification.
- ii. Exclusion from TuSoft-generated examination lists.
- iii. Inability for lecturers to record your marks in TuSoft.

Non-compliance will lead to mandatory deferment of studies for a period of **one (1) to two (2) academic years**.

No exceptions will be granted.

3. Examination Eligibility

Students are ineligible for examinations unless:

- i. The Official Nominal Roll has been signed; and
- ii. A minimum of 75% attendance has been attained in each registered course unit.


In accordance with the University Fees Payment Policy (available at www.tukenya.ac.ke), students are required to either:

- i. Pay the full semester fees at the beginning of the semester; or
- ii. Opt for the approved instalment plan as outlined below:
 - a. **First Instalment (60% of total fees):** On or before 13th March, 2026 (within the first three weeks of the semester).
 - b. **Final Balance (40%):** On or before 17th April, 2026 (by the end of the eighth week of the semester).

Non-compliance will result in denial of University services, including examination eligibility.
